The Centre for Research and Analysis on Migration (CReAM) is seeking to appoint up to two Postdoctoral/Senior Research Fellows and up to two Research Assistants for research into migration, education and the labour market. CReAM is an interdisciplinary research centre based in the Department of Economics at University College London (UCL). The individuals will work on projects funded by the ESRC and the Anglo-German Foundation under the programme, The Economics of Employment, Migration and Social Justice. Research is concerned with the economic and social effects of migration, the economic experience of immigrants, attitudes towards immigrants and minorities, labour market inequalities, and education. The successful candidates need a solid background in economics and statistical/ econometric analysis of micro data. They will make significant contributions to the research activity of the Centre in the areas described above or related areas. The positions range from one to three years, with a starting date asap, and the appointments will be on Grade 6B (starting from £21,467) for the Research Assistant post or Grade 7 (starting from £25,633) for the Research Fellow post, plus London allowance of £2,472 per annum.
