

Polish translator/ research assistant needed

CReAM (the Centre for Research and Analysis of Migration at the UCL Department of Economics, www.econ.ucl.ac.uk/cream) is looking for a Research Assistant/ translator to help in the translation of a dataset and the related questionnaires and documentation from Polish to English.

Suitable candidates should be fluent in both Polish and English, and preferably have some experience of working with survey data (although this is not necessary).

The exact amount of work involved is to be jointly determined, but we expect it to be not less than 20 hours. The hourly pay is £15.

Most of the work should be done in one of the CReAM offices in Drayton House, but some remote work arrangements can be made. Time allocation is flexible, but ideally the candidate should start her/his work as soon as possible.
